Happy Epiphany!

Epiphany is the season of the Church year that is often "lost" between the craziness of Christmas and the solemnity of Lent. Yet for the early church Epiphany was just as important as Christmas. It was set as a season of the church year in 361 and focused on the



manifestation of Christ to the Gentiles, the reality that Jesus enters into creation for all people.

This year we will celebrate Epiphany through the theme "Living in the Light". The Gospel of John often uses the image of Jesus being the light that shines God's Grace upon a darkened world. John also tells us time and time again that as followers of the Light we too are to be beacons of God's Grace to our world. The question for us is how to participate in this Light in the 21st century. Like the early church we live in a time of turmoil, a time that desperately needs the Light of Christ, a time of great opportunities to be Light bearers to an ever changing world.

Through the Gospel texts we will listen together to the voice of scripture as we bask in the Light of Christ and learn what it is to be a Light bearer in our world today.

Living in the Light - Is the worship theme for Epiphany and is based up the Gospels reading for each day.

Living in the Light – Receive January 11 Mark 1: 1-13 (piano lead worship at OSLC) It is God who chooses us! We receive life, we receive a relationship with Jesus, and we receive the Holy Spirit to live our life based upon our relationship Jesus.

Living in the Light – Believe January 18 John 1:43–51 (Organ/piano lead worship at OSLC with choir) Jesus knows us better than we know ourselves; he sees our true identity and invites us to see ourselves and the world through his eyes. Our belief is not in ourselves but in Jesus who gives our life meaning and purpose.

Living in the Light – Become January 25 Mark 1:14–20 (Guitar lead worship at OSLC) We become who we are created to be when we intentional put ourselves in a position to be changed by Jesus. We are invited to live a life based upon God's way of doing things (The Kingdom of God).
