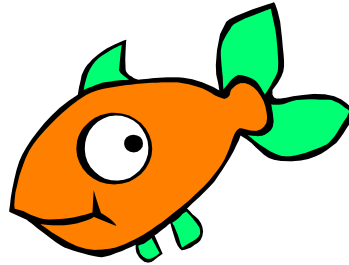

It is LUTEFISK time again!! Our 27th annual lutefisk dinner will be on Saturday, Feb. 6th. We will be serving this year from 11:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. With nearly 600 served last year, we need help with this project to make it a success. We also need help from OSLC Youth.



Lefse making for the lutefisk dinner will be on Saturday, January 16th and 23th from 7:00 AM until Noon on both days. If you know how or want to learn how to make lefse, please join us in the church basement. Also, if you have a lefse griddle and rolling pin, please bring it along to help. This is always a fun time of fellowship and storytelling!

We need all hands on deck as we hope to make 90 dozen lefse in two days!!

The rest of the schedule is as follows:

- Fri, February 5th - 9:00 a.m. Peel potatoes at the church
- Sat, February 6th - 6:00 a.m. Make meatballs (Westby Elem. School kitchen)
- 8:00 a.m. Set up at church

There are two shift on Saturday. 8:00 AM until 1:00 PM, and from 1:00 PM until everything has been cleaned up and put back (6:00 PM or so). Sign up for one or both shifts or just show up on Saturday and we will put you to work.

Norwegian pastries are needed as well. You can drop them off at the church the week prior to the dinner.
